



Furniture shipper leases Flower Mound industrial facility

A [North Carolina](#) shipping company that specializes in furniture hauling has rented a new industrial space in [Flower Mound](#).

Zenith Freight Lines has leased 168,988 square feet at 700 Lakeside Parkway. The building is owned by KTR Capital Partners.

With the new distribution space lease, the warehouse complex in the Lakeside Ranch Business Park is now fully rented, according to Stream Realty Partners senior vice president Blake Kendrick.

"Zenith Freight Lines is a new tenant to the town of Flower Mound," said Kendrick. "The property's proximity to DFW Airport, ability to be secured and trailer storage capacity made it ideal for Zenith's needs," Kendrick said Wednesday.

Kip Collins of Binswanger represented Zenith Freight in negotiations for the new location.

Zenith provides services including warehousing, consolidation and shipping container programs from locations in Asia, [North America](#), the Caribbean and Europe

The company has more than 4.5 million square feet of warehouse space in Southern California, Texas, Mississippi, North Carolina and Virginia.
