

Rainier Medical to build medical complex in Flower Mound

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A Dallas-based medical building developer is buying property in [Flower Mound](#) for a new project.

Rainier Medical Investments agreed to purchase 21 acres in the RiverWalk at Central Park development. The land is next to the new [Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital](#) Flower Mound.

Rainier Medical and partner Steve Belli of OGH Healthcare plan to build a medical complex, starting with a three-story, 75,000-square-foot office building.

“We intend to break ground late summer,” Rainier principal Daryn Eudaly said Wednesday in a statement. “We anticipate the building will be ready for occupancy 12 months from that time.”

The Riverwalk at Central Park is a 158-acre mixed-use development north of FM 1171 near Morriss Road.

Rainier Medical Investments was formed in November and recently acquired two buildings at Baylor Regional Medical Center at Grapevine. The company has also formed a fund to invest with physicians in medical facilities.
