ORDINANCE NO. 39-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FLOWER MOUND, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE III, DIVISION 2, ENTITLED "PARKS, ARTS, AND LIBRARY SERVICES (PALS) BOARD," SECTION 2-112, ENTITLED "ORGANIZATION," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF FLOWER MOUND, TEXAS, BY REDUCING THE NUMBER OF REGULAR MEMBERS; REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Flower Mound, Texas, has established certain Boards and Commissions that effectuate good government; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that a reduction in the number of regular members of the Parks, Arts, and Library Services (PALS) Board, would best serve the interests of the citizens of Flower Mound; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that these changes are desirable to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Flower Mound.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FLOWER MOUND, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1

All of the above premises are found to be true and correct factual and legislative determinations of the Town of Flower Mound and are hereby approved and are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION 2

From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, Chapter 2, Article III, Division 2, Section 2-112, entitled "Organization" shall be amended to omit any references to 9 regular members to read 7 regular members which shall be designated as places 1-7. There shall remain only 3 alternate members, which shall be designated as places 8-10. Any references to regular members over 7 members and any references to alternate members over 10 members shall hereby be repealed.

SECTION 3

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the Town of Flower Mound, Texas, except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4


It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Town Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since same would have been enacted by the Town Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section, and said remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


