Your Brush & Bulk will now be picked up weekly! The same guidelines apply.

RECYCLABLE ITEMS

Metal Containers

Food, beverage and soft drink cans made of tin, steel or aluminum; empty aerosol cans

Glass Containers

Unbroken food and beverage containers that are clear, brown or green in color. Labels need not be removed.

Paper Products

Flattened cardboard, magazines, office paper, newspaper, paperboard like cereal boxes, phone books, junk mail

Aseptic Packaging

Milk cartons; juice cartons; juice and drink boxes without the straws.

Plastics

Plastic containers with #1 - #7 resin code; also rigid plastics that will fit in the cart with lid closed such as plastic tubs and buckets, plastic toys, plastic hangers, nursery pots, small laundry baskets and similar products. Lids need not be removed.

Dishes

Metal pipe

Hardcover books

Containers with food in/on them

Containers with hazardous materials

PVC pipe

CDs and DVDs

Auto/window glass

Yard waste

Electronics

Light bulbs

Metal Coat hangers

Styrofoam of any kind

Syringes/Sharps
