



Home Pickup for Household Hazardous Waste Begins October 1

Clean out your garage and storage areas! As part of the new residential solid waste service with Waste Management, residents of Flower Mound have a NEW avenue to dispose of their Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). The residential HHW collection program provides for year-round door-to-door collections. To participate, you must contact the call center at 1-800-449-7587 to set up an appointment.

How Does it Work?

- 1.) **Call 800-449-7587 to request a collection:** When you call the collection hotline, you will be asked several questions, including your address and the type and amount of materials available for collection. You can also set up an appointment by email, atyourdoor@wm.com.
- 2.) **A collection date is scheduled and a kit is shipped:** The collection hotline operator will fully explain the program, schedule a convenient collection date and discuss where to place the kit for collection.
- 3.) **Preparing for collection:** The kit includes a program instruction sheet and other items to help pack and secure household hazardous waste. All materials such as gasoline, poisons, pesticides and aerosols, must be placed inside the kit. Other items may be placed outside the kit.
- 4.) **HHW material is collected:** On the scheduled date, the customer service technician will collect materials directly from your home. They will sort and pack the materials for proper disposal. Participants will receive a postage-paid survey card to complete and mail to your Town to help track the program.

The chart below shows the types of materials that must be placed inside the kit bag for collection, in addition to those items that are acceptable but may be placed outside the kit bag.

<i>Sharps – placed into a sealed rigid plastic container</i>		

MATERIAL THAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED: We do not collect ammunition, medicine, explosives, asbestos, or any materials in unlabeled or leaking containers.
