







Interactive Maps have a new design with all the same functionality as the old version with a new look. Go to <http://flowermound.dfwmaps.com> or access it under the Town's web site by going to Online Services then Interactive maps. One of the most notable changes are the new 2009 aerials and the speed at which they appear on the map.

### **Toolbar**

- The toolbar is located at the top of your screen. On the left is the  **Query Map** tool which allows you to identify a particular area by clicking on a location or feature on the map. This tool allows you to identify parcel information, land use information, zoning, subdivision name, 2000 Census Information, 2030 Demographic Forecast, and the Labor Market. All the demographics give you information within a radius of ½ to 10 miles of the point selected.
- Next is the Pan tool  used to navigate around your map by clicking on the map and dragging it to the location you want.
- The Zoom In  and Zoom Out  tools can also be used with the slide bar and the rollerball on the mouse.
- The Zoom to Extent  tool will take you to the extent of the Town. You can use the slider bar to view an even larger area.
- The navigate to the previous extent and back to the current extent tools. 
- The Clear Map tool will clear everything you have done back to a blank map.
- The Print/Export tool will convert your map to a .pdf file for printing or saving. You can also Email a Map, which will come in html format.

### **Find a Location Area**

- In the find location area to the left of the screen you can key in an address and hit go and it will navigate you to that location and you can also label the location.

### **Shortcuts for Viewing Map**

- Under the Toolbar you see Roads, Aerials, and Hybrid. These options allow you to see only roads on your map, only the aerials, or hybrid to see both roads and aerials.

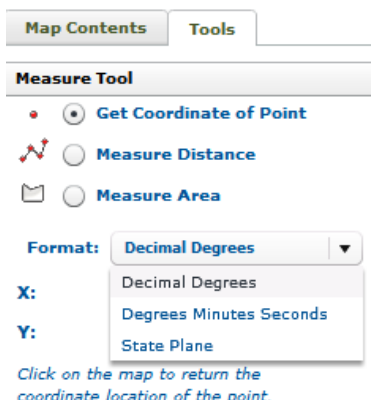
**Map Contents Tab**

- On the left portion of your screen under the Map Contents tab you have several options to select from by clicking the + button.
- Under Base Maps you have Town Limits, Facilities, Subdivisions, Trails, Schools, Zoning, Land Use and Parcels.
- The next selection is Contours, you can add the 2, 10, or 100 foot elevations. Annotation is displayed based on scale, so if you can't see all the contours zoom in further.
- 2009 Regional Aerials can also be added. Basemaps, Contours, and Aerials all give you the option to increase or decrease their transparency by clicking on the arrow next to them, this will pop up a slider to make your transparency adjustments.



**Tools Tab**

- Get Coordinate of Point allows you to get the x, y coordinates for a particular point on the map. You are able to change the format as displayed below:



- Measure Distance option allows you to draw a line from one point to another telling you the distance that you have drawn. You are able to change the distance format.
- Measure Area option allows you to measure the size of a parcel, building, etc., by Perimeter or Area.
