The Flower Mound Police Department will be hosting a Junior Police Academy this summer. The Academy class will be offered to any Flower Mound resident student who will be entering either the seventh or eighth grade in good standing with their respective school. Students will get a behind-the-scenes look at the Police Department. Our mission is to build rapport and good relationships with our youth that will last a lifetime.

A variety of topics will be covered such as the K-9 unit, traffic enforcement, criminal investigations, narcotics and SWAT. Some of the instruction will be classroom while the rest will be practical hands-on exercises. **The Registration cost for the course is a one time \$20 registration fee, made payable by cash or check to the Town of Flower Mound.** With the registration fee each child will receive a T-shirt, instruction manual, and memories that will last a lifetime.



Classes will be held Monday thru Friday from 8a to noon on the following weeks:

- **Session 1 June 18th — 22nd**
- **Session 2 July 16th — 20th**

Registration will open and applications will start being accepted at 8am on April 9, 2018. Completed application packets should be hand delivered to the Flower Mound Police Department no later than 12 p.m. Friday June 1, 2018. Classes are limited in size, and slots are filled on a first come first serve basis. Enrollment will be confirmed by the Crime Prevention Unit only after the application has been received.
