- ✓ Paint: latex & oil based
- ✓ Paint thinners, gasoline, solvents
- ✓ Oil, petroleum-based lubricants
- ✓ Ethylene glycol, antifreeze
- ✓ Pesticides, herbicides
- ✓ Aerosols
- ✓ Mercury, mercury and debris
- ✓ Batteries: lead acid, alkaline, NiCad
- ✓ Light bulbs: fluorescents, compact fluorescents (CFL), high-intensity
- ✓ HID lamps
- ✓ Pool Chemicals
- ✓ Cleaners: acidic & basic
- ✓ Resins & epoxy
- ✓ Medical Sharps
- ✓ Empty Propane Tanks

Unacceptable Household Hazardous Waste

- ✗ Commercially generated HHW or e-Waste
- ✗ Radioactive compounds
- ✗ Smoke Detectors
- ✗ Ammunition
- ✗ Explosives
- ✗ Tires
- ✗ Asbestos
- ✗ PCBs (polychlorinated biphenyls)
- ✗ Pharmaceuticals or controlled substances
- ✗ Biological or infectious wastes
- ✗ Fire Extinguishers
